We are pleased to confirm that on **Monday 7 July Year 3 and 4** will be going to **Go Ape at Bedgebury**.

We are sure the children will enjoy the Treetop Plus Adventure, an hour of adventurous fun as they make their way through the trees negotiating crossings and completing obstacles. They will be wearing helmets and harnesses during this exercise. Once their feet are back on the ground, they will continue with some team building and problem-solving activities in the form of Gorilla Games. We also hope to make use of the fabulous playgrounds in the park area.

We shall be travelling by coach, leaving school at 8.30am and we aim to be back at school by 5.30pm. **The children should arrive at school at 8.10am on the day for registration.** The children can wear their own clothes for this visit, which should be suitable for outdoor activities, and they should have a waterproof coat to wear on the day.
