	coast	The coast is where the sea meets land. It is a physical feature.		
	village	A village is an area where people and buildings are found. It is usually smaller than a town.		
	town	A town is an area with streets, houses, and buildings. It is usually larger than a village.		
	local area	A local area is the area which surrounds a place where people live.		
	settlement	A settlement is an area where people live.		
	physical geographical feature	A feature of an area which is natural such as woods, forest, beach, coast, cliff, park or field.		
	human geographical feature	A feature found in an area made by people such as buildings, shops, harbour, playground.
