Dear Parents/Carers,

Year 5 - Visit to the British Museum – Friday 17 October 2025

We are writing to let you know that there will be a History trip for Year 5 to the British Museum on Friday 17 October 2025, as part of our Topic work. This links with our Topic, Ancient Greeks, as we will be visiting the Ancient Greek exhibits as well as taking part in a workshop studying Ancient Greek democracy.

We will be travelling by train from Orpington to Charing Cross and using the tube to travel from Charing Cross to Tottenham Court Road, before walking to the venue (a walk of around 5 minutes). We will meet outside Orpington Station at 9:15am (on the taxi rank side). Please drop your child off at the station (ensuring there is a member of staff there to receive them). We will return to Orpington Station by 2.45pm, should the arrival back at the station be delayed, a text message will be sent to all parents. You may collect your child from the station at 2.45pm.

A packed lunch can be provided for the children if required, via our catering contractor, consisting of either a ham, tuna, or cheddar sandwich or baguette, a piece of fruit, a bottle of water and either a biscuit or piece of cake.

There is a charge of £3.00 towards the cost of this trip, which can be paid via the Arbor parent portal. Although the charge for the trip is voluntary, if we do not receive enough contributions from families the visit will have to be cancelled. If you are eligible for and have registered for free school meals this trip will be paid for by the school.

The children must wear smart correct school uniform and please do not send any pocket money as we will not be visiting the shop. Children should not bring mobile phones on this trip.

Please complete the permission slip below and return to us as soon as possible, indicating your child's packed lunch preference, and confirmation that you have made payment of the £3.00 contribution on the Arbor parent portal.

We would like to take some parent/carer helpers with us on this trip. If you would be able to help, please let us know on the permission slip.
